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## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This competition is open to students who are from a recognised training institution, art college, university course or film school. You enter by completing and signing the 'terms & conditions' document and the 'guidelines document'.

You will be able to locate and download an EPS file of the David Hockney logo from this website. Please note that the Adobe illustrator versions of the logo has been chopped into helpful layers for you to be able to dismantle easily and animate. CS2, CS3, and CS4 Adobe Illustrator versions (.eps) on mailbigfile. This should cover all levels of system softwares.

You submit three copies of your animation of not more than one minute on a DVD, any format, in standard 720 x 576 pixels, together with your completed registration form plus signed terms and conditions, clearly addressing the envelope to: Ms Brenda Whitehead, David Hockney Logo Animation Competition Book Awards, BFI, 21 Stephen Street London W1T 1LN from any time up until Tuesday 31st March 2009.

Entrants are responsible for obtaining the consent to use any underlying works such as added music, used in the moving image work. All submissions will be vetted and may be rejected at the sole discretion of the And/or Book Award Judges who include: David Hockney CH RA himself, David Sproston CBE (co-founder and co-owner of Aardman Films) and Amanda Nevill (Chairman, British Film Institute).

You will be required to provide valid email address, mobile, telephone number and postcode on the registration form. In the event that the complete and correct information is not provided, the form will be considered incomplete and therefore invalid. Information regarding personal data provided in the form will be collected, stored and processed in a database for the purposes of managing the website and entry into the award.

Such information will not be used for any other purpose other than for the selection, presentation and promotion of the winning works. You hereby agree that we may use your personal data to confirm by email your successful registration and upload of work, and for notifying you in the event of a short list or if you find yourself the winner of the award.

You agree that your work will be available online for viewing, and your work will be sharable, broadcastable and sourceable.

David Hockney has released the copyright of this work for the exclusive use in this logo competition and it is not available for use in any other form without his prior permission to do so. Please ensure that the David Hockney copyright is acknowledged in your work.

There is no cash prize or fee for any use whatsoever of your animation by the Kraszna-Krausz Charitable Foundation, but the winner will get to spend a day with David Hockney in his studio in Bridlington with all expenses paid for by the Kraszna-Krausz Foundation. They will be invited to the Awards Ceremony at BFI Southbank on Thursday 23rd April 2009 where their work will be screened. Runners-up will also be offered a screening at the Awards ceremony. Press releases following the award ceremony will include details of the winner and the college they are attending. These details will thereafter be added to the Kraszna-Krausz Foundation website.

The award selection will take place some time after Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2009 and the winner will be contacted at least 10 days prior to the awards ceremony to enable appropriate travel arrangements to be made.

By entering an application for the award, the applicant will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the Terms and Conditions. All entry instructions forms, the Registration form and the Guidelines form part of the Terms and Conditions.
